Alice attended Tri-Community Elementary School; she then attended East High School for two years and graduated from Merry High School in the class of 1970. She was a very warm, caring and trustworthy person which resulted in her having lifetime friends.

Alice was also one of the lead block watch facilitators in her community in Memphis, and residents have expressed a deep appreciation for her.
