She always invited him, and he came with his wife, to the Legion for their annual Cotton Club Dance. She helped the Legion obtain/secure a \$90,000 loan to pay off back taxes. She supervised and advised the Legion managers in how to deal with a murder that took place on Legion property by having the Legion hire a law firm she recommended to work with the Legion to resolve many issues around the situation. She was always instrumental in meeting with the city, attorneys, other posts; truly a Commander who cared about the American Legion Family. My wife, Diana, and I took her on many occasions to see her family in Jackson, Tn. We are eternally grateful for Ms. Anna Wall Scott.*

So within three weeks, the memorial was organized and was a success! Duly noted by Ms. Scott were her wonderful words in a letter to the News Gazette Editor in September 2007, after the memorial acknowledging such a great event much welcomed at the Legion. With the exception of 1 year, this memorial event has continued at the Post every year since then! She, along with my family, became one of my biggest supporters during my 2 year tenure as Auxiliary President. Another is the Auxiliary's event on May 31 of this year, saluting /honoring our WWII and Korean War Veterans at Post 559. Ms. Scott's health was continuing to decline so in addition to filming the event (on UPTV/ YouTube), we were able to have her on the phone during the Post 559 Color Guard's posting of colors and the reading of her Salute. What a great way to honor someone who loves God, this country, her family, this community and most definitely the American Legion Post 559. She has left her mark from Michigan Avenue and other parts of Urbana, to the American Legion Post 559 (in all 3 of its locations), to Parkland College in West Champaign. And that's just in Champaign-Urbana! She will be long remembered for all she brought to all people...everywhere...she Commanded(r) respect!
