



Mr. Carlton Lee "Picture Man" Womack

June 4, 1945 - January 20, 2024

Carlton Lee "Picture Man" Womack was born on June 4, 1945, in Denmark, Tennessee, to the late Benjamin Womack and Mary Bryant-Fuller, who preceded him in death.

At the age of twelve, Carlton moved to Painsville, Ohio, where he attended school and graduated from Harvey High School.

In 1964, Carlton married his high school sweetheart, Henriene Jeffries. To this union, three beautiful daughters were born.

Carlton soon after joined the U.S. Air Force, where he served twenty years before retiring. His time in the Air Force allowed him the opportunity to travel to forty-two states and several foreign countries. After retiring from the Air Force, Carlton went on to get his associate's degree in Arkansas while working at J.C. Penney's and the Little Rock Air Force Base Gym.

In 1987, Carlton moved his family to Texas, where he worked at Texas Instruments (Now Raytheon). He later worked for the Texas Department of Transportation and retired in June 2011.

Carlton lost many loved ones throughout his life: Henriene, his first wife; a much loved grandson, Kholwani K. Sibanda; two loving sisters, Imogene

Bafford and Hiawatha Howard; and his dear brother, Author Lee Bryant.

Carlton found love again and married Patricia Williams-Womack in January of 2011. Together, they raised a grandson, who was more like a son, DeMahri Taylor.

Carlton was survived by: his wife, Patricia Womack; three daughters, Carla (Andrew) Roberson, Corrine (Sanelle) Sibanda, and Carletha Woman; he also opened his heart to his second wife's children, Tracy Jarett-Williams, Andre' Williams, and Dawn Williams; one sister, Rose Mary Fuller; granddaughters, April and Carleen Roberson, and Aaliyah and Lindani Sibanda; one great-grandson, Adonis Robinson; a special Air Force friend, Marc Smith, whom Carlton also loved like a son; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
