



Mrs. Carolyn Bridges Corley

August 19, 1957 - February 20, 2015

Carolyn Corley was from Title Town USA- Valdosta GA. She was a Professional School Counselor in the Jackson Madison County School System for the last 14 years.

She was born August 19, 1957 in Brooklyn, NY. As a young girl she was raised in Valdosta, GA. She graduated from Valdosta High School at the age of 16. She then attended Valdosta State University in Valdosta, GA. After that, she transferred and received her A.A. Degree from Southwestern Christian College, and then she received her B.A in Mass Communication from Freed-Hardeman College in 1978.

She was employed as a dorm supervisor with Freed Hardeman University for four years, before she earned her Masters Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from FH-U. She taught in the Chester County School System at the high school level for four years, at the elementary level in JMCSS for five years, and counselor for over 14 years. She went on to receive a Doctorial of Philosophy Degree from Clayton College of Natural Health in Holistic Nutrition, where she received highest honors. Finally, in May 2011, she received her Education Specialist Degree from Freed-Hardeman University.

Carolyn received various awards in the 1970's, 80's and 90's. Among her most cherished was when she was crowned Miss Black Valdosta in 1974.

Other awards include The Old Hickory Mall Teacher Appreciation Award-2000, The Most Distinguished 4th Grade Teacher Award-2006, and The National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa Inc. Educator of the Year by Gamma Psi Chapter-2006.

However, her greatest award was finally given on July 27, 1979 when Charles presented her with the award of WIFE. In 1980 and 1984, he again presented her with the greatest reward of all, the title of MOMMA to their wonderful daughters Toni and Candice.

She loved God with all her heart and was a faithful member of the Church of Christ.

She is survived by her husband Charles Corley and two daughters, Toni and Candice, one sister, Shelia Mitchell (Jerome) of Valdosta, GA and a host of loving aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
