Donnie Bradford, Sr. who entered eternal rest September 7, 2024, was born May 15, 1947, in Humboldt, TN to the late Rev. Ben Bradford and the late Lillie M. Patterson Bradford.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was a lifelong member of Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church (Humboldt, TN). He served as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, and worked with many auxiliaries.

He attended Phillips School and graduated from Stigall High School (Humboldt, TN) in 1964. Donnie and Rose met in 1960 to a bond that lasted until his transition. After completing high school, he enlisted into the United States Air Force in 1965 and served during the Vietnam War. For over 40 years, he was employed at Eaton Axle (Dana) Corporation. While at Dana, he was instrumental with his fellow coworkers to start the Union for the Humboldt, TN location. Later in his life, Donnie graduated from American Baptist College (Jackson, TN location).

He was united in holy matrimony to Rose Simmons Bradford on September 19, 1970. God blessed this union with two sons, Donnie M. Bradford and

David J. Bradford. He was the father to his daughter Donneka Johnson.

He loved family reunions where he was often at the center of the group laughing, cutting up and telling history with his close-knit family.
