Throughout most of Ernest life he worked as a Security Guard for Maxx Guard and served as a Constable for Madison County. He was well known and deeply loved by everyone that knew him. He also helped and touched many hearts during his lifetime and led people to Christ.

He was a distinguished professional with a multifaceted career spanning various domains. Initially appointed as a Special Agent by the American Police Academy in Washington, DC, he played a pivotal role in the

Meadows has honed his skills through extensive training in law enforcement, martial arts, natural herbs, counseling, and Christian studies.

His diverse expertise led him to attain the status of a Master Herbalist, Spiritual Counselor, and ordained minister from the Universal Church, with a special recognition of Sainthood from the Church of the Gifted.
