Ernest Lee Sharp transitioned life on March 23, 2026 after a short illness. He was preceded in death by his parents, Wilson Sharp and Alma Louise Rooks-Sharp, a brother Billy Sharp, sister Alma Rooks-Luper, and a sister Doris Jean Sharp.

Ernest attended the public schools of Jackson, Tennessee, and enlisted in the army at an early age to fight for his country in the Vietnam War.
