Ernestine “Tina” Mables McKinney was born on August 5, 1934 in East St. Louis, Illinois. She departed to eternal life on October 27, 2023 at her home. Ernestine was raised by her loving Uncle Charlie and Aunt Marjorie Mabry. She and her Aunt Marjorie moved to St. Louis, Missouri after the passing of her Uncle Charlie in 1960.

Ernestine received her elementary and secondary education in the East St. Louis area school system. She graduated from Lovejoy High School in Brooklyn Illinois, class of 1953. Her efforts toward higher learning were unchangeable through the years of her adult life, as she continuously pursued her career objectives. Her goal was to become an elementary school teacher, working with children who she loved so dearly.
