Georgia “Emma” Graves-Webb was born September 20, 1927 to George Richard and Emma “Bell” Graves in Stanton (Haywood County) Tennessee. God called her home to be with him on Friday, May 24, 2013.

She was educated at Douglas School in Haywood County and Gibson County Training School, Milan, TN.

She was a basketball player. She received her Bachelor’s degree from Lane College, Jackson, Tennessee. She finished numerous professional development courses. She paid for her education by picking and chopping cotton and substitute teaching through Gibson County.

She had to catch rides to Jackson with people who lived in Milan because she worked in Jackson.

She initially started teaching at Persimmon Grove (Wade and Ganaway Families). She served as Principal at Persimmon Grove. She continued her career teaching at Fly School, Medina Elementary School, Gibson County Training School and Polk-Clark School in Milan, Tennessee.

She was baptized at an early age. She was a member of St. John Missionary Baptist Church in Stanton, TN and St. Paul Missionary Baptist church in Milan

serving by helping in cleaning and decorating the church.

Georgia married Willie B. Webb, who preceded her in death, August 25, 1946. To this union two children were born: Lula Webb-Grolich and Richard B. Webb.

She leaves to mourn her loss; two children: Lula A. (Timothy) Webb-Grolich of Scottsdale, AZ and Richard Bertram Webb of Milan, TN; two sisters: Annice Williams and Odella Atkins of Detroit MI; one brother, James A.
