From organizing girl clubs, making up dance routines, getting wet on the slip and slide, riding bikes to Piggly Wiggly, kickball, hide and seek, sneaking popsicles out of the house, getting toes popped by her dad (Uncle June) to see how

many stories were told, having fun and loving life, Keisha's place was it!

In addition, Keisha loved children. She never turned a cousin or a friend down when they needed a babysitter. If you needed to borrow her car because yours was broken down, Keisha was your girl. One of her cousins has her car right now, because of a broken-down vehicle.

She was a lover of Sonic's ice (the North Parkway location only), butterflies, and starburst candy. Making and buying reborn baby dolls, chilling with Netflix, Hulu, Prime, I-Phone games, Tyler Perry's Sistas and telling people what and how to do were her past time hobbies.
