Stella Mainone Jelks Dupree transitioned from life to eternal rest on January 13, 2024 surrounded by her children after sharing 91 years of love, laughter, kindness, and true caring for her family, friends, church and community. Born on November 22, 1932, in Maury City, Tennessee to the late Ervin Daniel Jelks and Susie Ella Klyce Jelks. She was blessed to see many world events and innovations that developed over her long life.

The tempo of Mainone's life was set at an early age when she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior and joined First Baptist that later became New First Baptist in Maury City, Tennessee. Mainone inherited her talent and love for singing from both her parents. She had a beautiful alto voice and could switch to tenor when needed for some of the choir songs.

Mainone attended Maury City Elementary School, was a very bright student and often competed in the Spelling Bees. Afterwards, she attended Central High School in Alamo, TN. She was the senior class Historian and graduated in the class of 1949. After high school she attended Tennessee A. & I. State College, now Tennessee State University.

Mainone was a devoted wife from the time she married her husband Montell Dupree until his death in 1988. They were married for thirty six years, to this union four children were born.
