

Mr. Mike Reaves Jr.

July 3, 1949 - August 16, 2022

He has a smile that makes you smile too, even now. Born on July 3, 1949, Mike Reaves, Jr., was the oldest son of the late Mike Reaves, Sr., and Maudie Lee “Mudear” Reaves of Jackson, Tennessee.

A quiet mama’s boy, “Junior” showed an early interest in sports. Growing up on Eastern Avenue, now known as James Buchanan Drive, he excelled in baseball and basketball in the neighborhood. He later went on to play basketball and football for Merry High School, the 1967 graduate serving as captain of the school’s basketball and football teams.

He was always protective of his older sister, Lawanda Faye. She said she could “never get a boyfriend in school!” While a young man spoke to her at the locker, she fondly recalled her brother saying “You better leave my sister alone!” Junior showed up for those he loved and when he loved you, you knew it.

It was during his Junior year of high school, when he met Linda Muse, the young lady who would become the love of his life. The Merry High sophomore used to always wonder why the cute guy was giving Lawanda Faye a hug in home economics. She later learned the pair were siblings.

After three years of dating, Mike and Linda said “ I do” on November 17, 1968. For nearly 54 years, the couple built a life together in Jackson, Tennessee, sharing a passion for sports, travel and music. Mike would eventually serve as the road manager for Lanier & Company, covering thousands of miles for the band’s many performances.

A U.S. Army Veteran, Mike served his country from 1969 to 1971, deploying to Korea during his tenure. He would later work several jobs before landing at the U.S. Postal Service from 1987-2009. Still, for this doting father, no job compared to his role as dad.

For years, Mike worked overnights, unloading mail trucks and arriving home in time to drop his daughter, Shayla, off at school each morning. He was always first in the school

pickup line each afternoon. He always knew what to say when life felt tough.

From graduations to awards ceremonies, the proud father never missed a moment to talk about his only daughter. “You need to get you one of these,” he once said to a young reporter, proudly holding Shayla’s first Emmy award. When he would go for haircuts, he always wanted to make sure he got out before noon to watch her television broadcasts on his Kindle.

For more than 50 years, he was a member of the Tabernacle of David the House of Israel, affectionately known to many as “Brother Mike” and “Brother Mac.” He would become a minister, passionate about his faith and his church family.

Mike Reaves, Jr., was preceded in death by his parents, Mike Reaves, Sr., and Maudie Lee Banks Reaves of Jackson, Tennessee, and his brother, Joseph Allen Reaves.

He is survived by his wife, Linda Muse Reaves of Jackson, Tennessee; daughter, Shayla Reaves Bhojani (Shawn) of Minneapolis, Minnesota; his sister Lawanda Faye Crayton of Jackson, Tennessee; sister-in-law, Sharinda Denise Muse, of Jackson, Tennessee; and a host of nieces, nephews, and close friends.

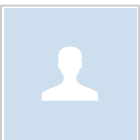
