He attended Jackson Central Merry High School and graduated in 1980. The following year, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and attended basic training in Camp Lejeune in North Carolina.

Dale was a proud veteran having served in the United States Marine Corp and the United States Army and was honorably discharged from both branches of service. He was a member of the National Rifle Association and served in the Jackson chapter of the Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club. Dale was the owner of Serious Gun Training, where he instructed individuals on gun safety and assisted them in obtaining their handgun carry permits. In his spare time, he enjoyed working on cars, playing the bass guitar, and spending time with his grandchildren.

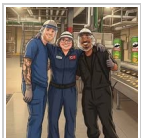
