Odell Dupree was born to the late Winston and Lula Dupree on September 19, 1948, in Alamo, Tennessee. On October 10, 2025, he peacefully answered God's call and transitioned to his heavenly home.

Odell was the youngest of eight siblings and was preceded in death by his sisters, Martha Elizabeth Preston, Emma Lee Dupree Lundy, Shirley Jurnette Dupree, Evelyn Dupree Harris. He was also preceded in death by his beloved son, Michael Dupree.

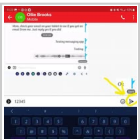

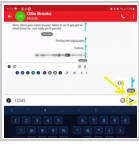
