



## Mrs. Selma Salena Marshall

December 9, 1932 - August 19, 2011

Mother Selma Salena Bell Marshall was born December 9, 1932 in Sharkey County, Mississippi, the first child born to the union of the late Theodore Roosevelt Bell, Sr., and the late Mother Estella Bell Reaves.

Mother Marshall accepted God as her personal savior at an early age at the Church of God in Hollandale, Mississippi, under the leadership of her grandfather, Bishop Tobias Bell. Mother Marshall married George Ivory Marshall on November 29, 1953. Mother Marshall later joined with the Church of God in Medon, TN, where she served as Choir Director for many years, and has also served as a First Lady, Sunday School Teacher, Cook, and Secretary. She never found her hands idle and was a faithful and devoted member of the Church of God even in declining health. Mother Marshall graduated from the State of Mississippi's educational system where she earned her High School Diploma. Mother Marshall was a homemaker, seamstress and domestic laborer. She worked at Oakley Fashion and the Jackson-Madison County School System, where she retired after over a decade of employment. She enjoyed many hobbies such as sewing, baking, canning, reading, traveling, trying new and different recipes, listening to gospel music and singing. She had a genuine love for her family and friends, always ready to lend a helping hand or offer words of encouragement.
