



Mr. Timothy Wayne Clifford

November 2, 1958 - June 21, 2013

Timothy Wayne Clifford was born November 2, 1958 in Indianapolis, IN. He was the youngest child of James and Eunice Hart Clifford. He departed this life Friday night, June 21, 2013 at Methodist University Hospital in Memphis, TN, after a lengthy illness. He was 54 years old.

Timothy was baptized at the Kingsley Terrace Church of Christ under the leadership of the late Bro. G.P. Holt in Indianapolis, IN. He was strong in his faith, very knowledgeable of the scripture, and held a sound doctrine as a member of the Church of Christ. He was willing to share scripture and would teach people about the Church through bible classes, prison ministry and general conversation.

While in Memphis, Timothy placed membership at the James Road Church of Christ and remained a faithful member until death.

He graduated from Arlington High School in Indianapolis, IN and furthered education over the years in theology, computer technology, and substance abuse counseling.

Timothy worked for the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D.C. for 17 years before retiring. He worked on jobs in security, manufacturing and shipping until finally working for the Memphis Police Department beginning in

2002.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a sister, Algerine Echols, and a brother, Jackie Clifford.
